Andrea Priori-Meintel is the Director of the Bureau of Treatment Services for the PA Department of Corrections. She began her correctional career in 1992 at SCI Camp Hill, working in the Diagnostic and Classification Center (CDCC) as a Psychological Services Specialist. She has also held positions as Corrections Classification Treatment Manager, CDCC Mental Health Director, as well as Staff Assistant to the Executive Deputy Secretary. Ms. Priori-Meintel received her B.A. from Gettysburg College with a double major in psychology and biology. She earned an M.S. from Millersville University in psychology, and has completed much of her doctoral work at Penn State University in Adult Education and Community Psychology.
